Author Profile

Both the *Iliad* and the *Odyssey* are attributed to Homer, the first and greatest of the Greek poets. Homer’s biographical dates are a matter of conjecture, as is his actual existence. Legend characterizes him as a blind minstrel who wandered Greece, singing his epic poems in the ancient oral tradition.

Artist Profile

American artist and illustrator Newell Convers Wyeth (1882–1945) was a student of Howard Pyle. He created more than 3,000 paintings and illustrated more than 100 books. His home and studio in Chadds Ford, Pennsylvania, are designated as a National Historic Landmark.

Translator Profile

American poet William Cullen Bryant (1794–1878) was also a lawyer, journalist, and long-time editor of the *New-York Evening Post*. He studied Greek and Latin in his youth, and in his old age he revisited his love of the classics to write blank-verse translations of both the *Iliad* and the *Odyssey*.

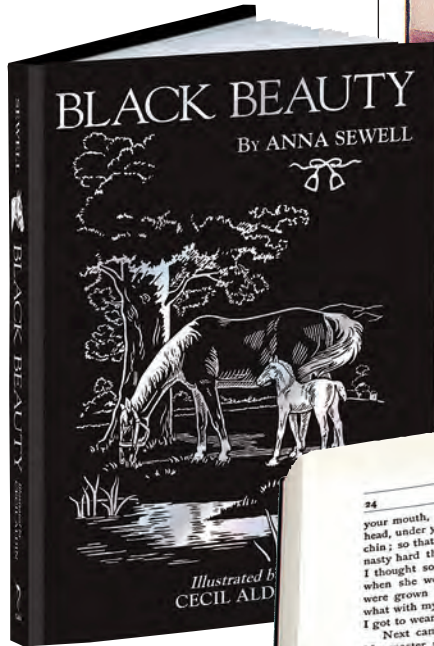

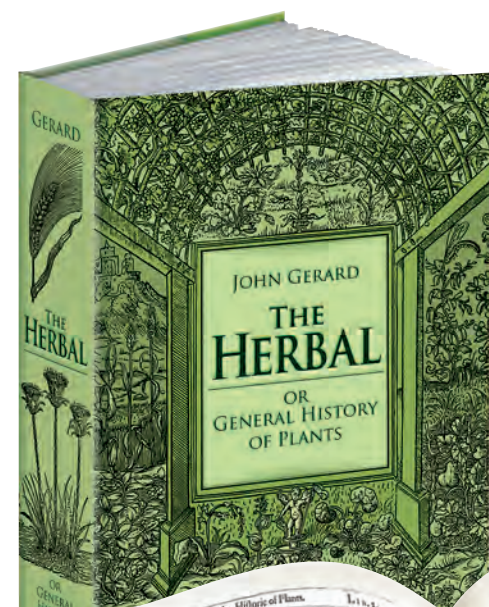

Author Profile

Anna Sewell (1820–78) suffered a childhood injury to both ankles that forced her to rely upon horse-drawn transportation for the rest of her life. Sewell's love of horses and concern for their humane treatment inspired the creation of her only book, *Black Beauty*, which has touched the hearts of generations of readers since its 1877 publication.

Artist Profile

Cecil Aldin (1870–1935) is renowned for his paintings of animals and rural life as well as for his book and magazine illustrations of equestrian scenes. An avid sportsman and Master of Foxhounds, he served as a Remount Purchasing Officer during World War I and was active in training horses for army service.

Each plant features Latin and English names, physical description, place and time of growth, scientific and folkloric details, and in virtually every case, a fine woodcut illustration. This 1633 Gerard-Johnson edition describes about 2,850 plants and has about 2,700 illustrations.

Author Profiles

John Gerard (1545–1612) was an English gardener and botanist. First published in 1597, his great *Herbal* was largely based on an English translation of a Dutch source, Rembert Dodoens' Latin herbal of 1583, and most of the illustrations were also from previously published sources. Nevertheless, it quickly became the most popular and best known early English botany book.

Thomas Johnson (d. 1644) was a London botanist and apothecary. He added about 800 species and approximately 700 new illustrations plus various corrections to Gerard's original text. He was about 40 years old when he died from wounds received during an English civil war battle.

HOWARD PYLE

1856-1911, AMERICAN



So much of the art form that is illustration has been shaped by the efforts of Howard Pyle, that he is often referred to as the father of American illustration. Pyle's areas of specialty were American historicals, medieval period works, (which were very popular in the fiction market at the time) and pirates. It is largely from Howard Pyle's own research and imagery, that we have our current visual idea of what a pirate looks like.

Based in the Wilmington, Delaware area, Pyle worked with publishers in both Philadelphia and New York. After a successful entry into the field at the close of the nineteenth century, Pyle put himself in a position to be one of the biggest stars in an emerging profession, not only as an illustrator, but as an author as well. Not finding enough material to fuel his artistic passions, he found that writing and illustrating together allowed him the freedom to choose his own subjects. He would go on to produce numerous children's books and adventure stories, most in the earlier part of his career, as well as become a regular contributor of articles for many of the magazines he worked for.

Pyle shared his success willingly and began teaching in the Philadelphia area at Drexel University in 1894. His lectures were well attended, often by young artists coming from great distances, looking for a chance to get some benefit from his experience. Pyle's frustration with a lack of real commitment from too many students led him to an experiment which changed the field in the U.S., and the ripples from it are still having effects today. In 1900 he left Drexel and shortly after founded the Howard Pyle School of Art. Taking on students only after personal interviews, each was hand selected by Pyle, and showed the necessary promise that Pyle felt was needed to shape them into a professional. Students that went through Pyle's program were among the best American illustrators of the day, and many were so impressed with Pyle that a good many of them became strong teachers of the craft as well. Classes during the year were held in Wilmington, while summer studios were held at a mill in Chadd's Ford Pa., on the Brandywine river. It is this river and the surrounding valley that give name to the "Brandywine School," Pyle's particular fashion of illustration.
