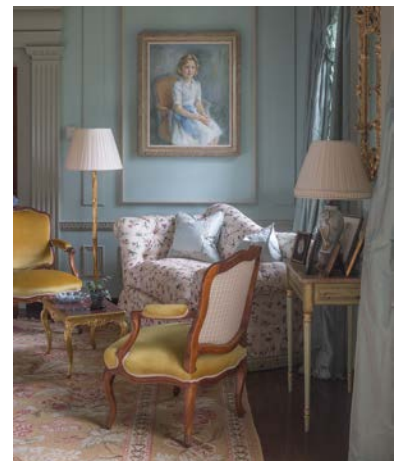
## LETA AUSTIN FOSTER, SALLIE GIORDANO & INDIA FOSTER

**CRAWFISH ÉTOUFFÉE**

**SERVES 5 TO 7**

*In Louisiana we have a Crawfish season—from February into May, sometimes later. These crawfish are a specialty for people not only in Louisiana but all over the country.*

- 2 pounds Louisiana crawfish tails
- 1 ½ sticks butter
- 1 large bell pepper, diced
- 1 large onion, diced
- 2 teaspoons minced garlic
- 3 green onions, chopped
- 2 tablespoons GatorQueen's Bayou Seasoning
- ½ cup Worcestershire sauce
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon parsley flakes
- 1 tablespoon prepared mustard
- 1 (10-ounce) can cream of mushroom soup
- 1 (10-ounce) can Milt's Hot! Diced Tomatoes and Green Chiles
- 2 cups water

Rinse your crawfish tails, place them in a bowl and set aside.

In a large pot melt the butter. Add the peppers, onions, garlic, and green onions. Sauté until the vegetables are softened and slightly brown. Add your crawfish, stirring well for about 5 minutes. Then add the Bayou seasoning, Worcestershire sauce, salt, parsley flakes, mustard, soup, hot sauce, and water. Cook on low heat until water has cooked out and gravy is thick, about 20 minutes.

Serve over rice, with a green salad on the side. Or serve over fried fish with cheddar cheese sprinkled on top. Yum, yum!

Included is work from all periods of Teater’s life and in all of his motifs, especially as they relate to Idaho, the Grand Tetons, and Jackson Hole, Wyoming, but also including representative selections from his “International Collection,” gleaned from his travels to more than one hundred countries around the world, including from New York City, San Francisco, New Orleans, Uruguay, France, Spain, Switzerland, Australia, New Zealand, Hong Kong, Egypt and Afghanistan.

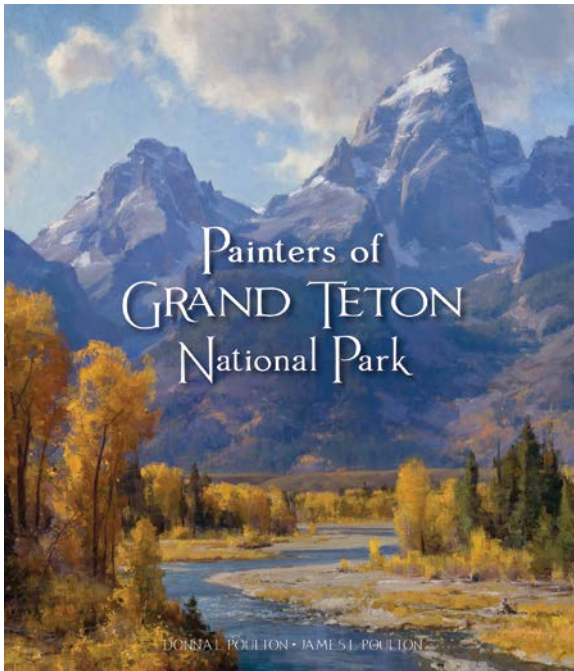
