The Art of Polyhedral Paper Folding

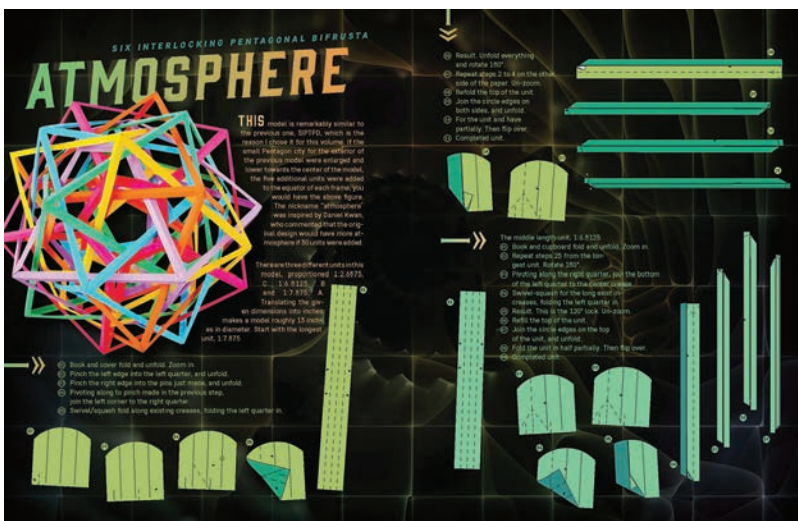
Complex, stunning, and exceedingly popular, modular origami has taken the origami world by storm. Using basic geometry concepts and simple paper folding techniques, folders can turn multiple flat pieces of paper into a dynamic three-dimensional model by deftly fitting the pieces together. From paper polyhedra to bristling buckyballs to ornate flower-like spheres, *Mind-Blowing Modular Origami* is a spectacular collection of paper crafting designs!

In modular folding, multiple pieces of paper are held together by the tension of the other pieces, demonstrating the remarkable properties of paper—flexible and strong. The larger the model, the more base pieces required and the more complexity involved in putting the final project together. Author Byriah Loper pushes the limits of this art form with some of the largest, most complex geometric paper constructions ever assembled. Loper pioneered the open, linear "wire frame" approach, rather than following in the path of many geo-modular artists who focus on creating dense floral spheres. His models result in a complex-looking piece that reveals the interior of its form. A combination of both kinds of models can be

found in this book, ranging from conventional "buckyball" pieces to the impressive "Alphabet" model which is the final project in the book—the largest wire frame modular ever made.

The easy-to-follow diagrams and step-by-step instructions clearly illustrate how to fold the paper components and then assemble them to create 22 incredible models. Each model is a new challenge that pushes origami artists to expand the boundaries of complex folding.

Byriah Loper has folded origami for five years. His interest in origami art began with the discovery of a paper airplane calendar, which inspired him to model more complicated objects out of paper. Loper quickly discovered modular origami, and has since designed and folded more than 250 original works. He is a student at Asbury University in Kentucky.

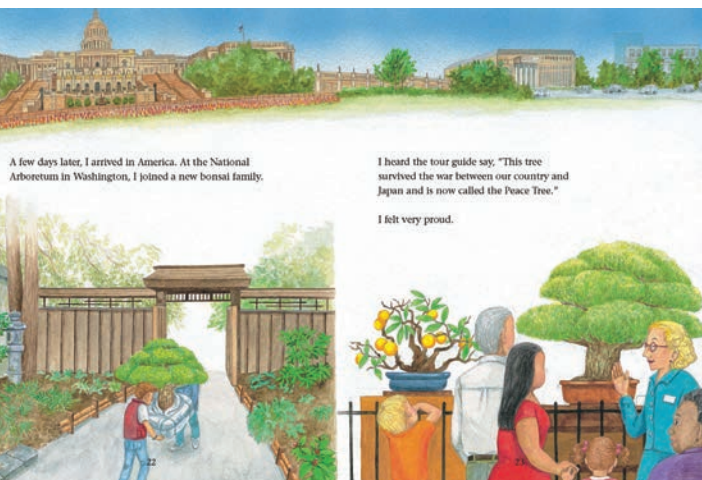
The Yamaki family was a family of bonsai masters. Tended for over 300 years by generations of fathers and sons, Miyajima loved being a bonsai tree and loved the Yamaki family. Many people died, but the Yamaki family and Miyajima, along with all their other bonsai trees, survived the tragedy.

Life went on for the little tree, until one day in 1976, a truck arrived to take Miyajima away. The little bonsai tree was on its way to the National Arboretum in Washington, DC, as a gift of friendship from Japan to America. Miyajima was so proud to be a part of this gift, but also very sad to leave the Yamaki family and his home.

Many years later, Masaru, the elderly grandfather of the Yamaki family, and his ten-year-old grandson, Akira, make a surprise visit to Washington. They head directly to the National Arboretum to visit their much missed and beloved family member, Miyajima. 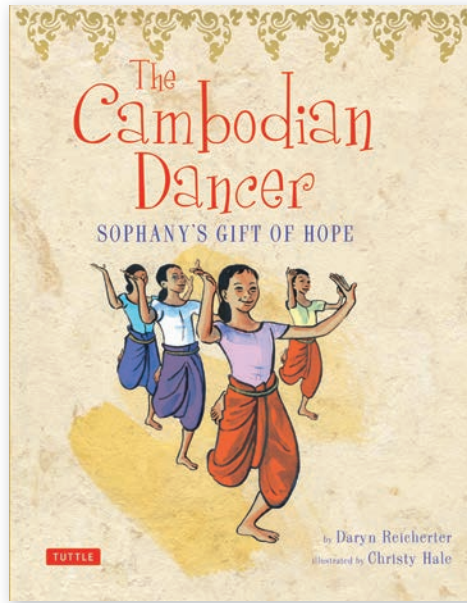
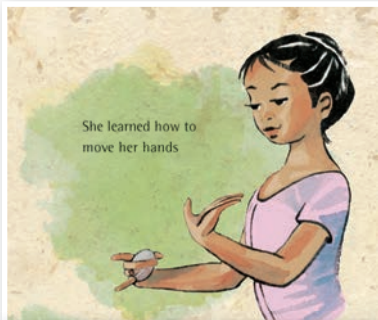

He is an activist for human rights in the area of war crime through the programs he serves, and beyond.

Christy Hale is an award-winning writer, illustrator and designer of children's books whose work has been honored by *Horn Book*, the American Library Association, the International Reading Association and others. This novel provides a first-person look at adolescence in 1950s and 60s Shanghai, a time and place of enormous political upheaval in the lives of even the most ordinary people. We follow our young narrator as he navigates the difficulties anyone might face growing up: shifting loyalties among friends, conflicts with adults in his life, and an array of family troubles, set against the turbulent backdrop of China under the leadership of Mao Zedong.

All throughout China, urban youth were relocated to the countryside to join forced labor camps. Our narrator too shares this fate. Among the novel's carefully drawn characters is the city itself, as the author depicts the culture and customs unique to Shanghai during this period.

In his striking picture of a "normal" young man, the author captures the lives of many unknown and unremembered individuals whose destinies were influenced by political movements. *Normal People* quite poignantly represents the memory of the youth of a generation.

Shen Shanzeng is a writer and director whose published works include the literary notes, *Shanghai Natives*, and *When the Muse Extends Her Goldfinger*. Since the late 1990s, he has turned his attention to Chinese classics, producing a series of his own interpretations including *Give Me Back Zhuangzi* and *Give Me Back Laozi*.

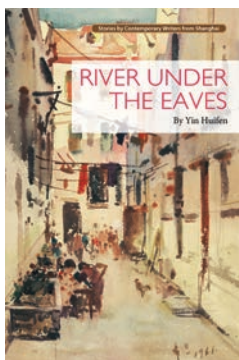
